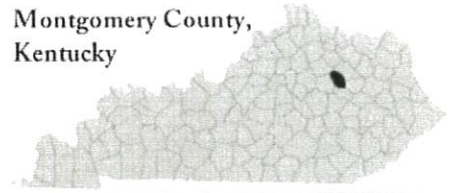
Investments in aviation infrastructure will help ensure the City of Mt. Sterling remains well positioned to attract new industry and support the continued growth of existing employers.
