Congressman Barr,

I am writing to you on behalf of the City of Mount Sterling to ask for your support and assistance with our application for the Post Clinic. Late last year, the Post Clinic, with the assistance of Gateway Area Development District, applied for funding to construct a new building to the Kentucky Department of Local Government and to the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC). Sadly, ARC rejected the application, which would have greatly benefited the citizens of not only our community, but those of 16 other Kentucky counties. Our city is committed to this project and to improving the health care alternatives for our citizens, many of whom are fully employed and unable to meet the costs of health insurance premiums or copays. The Post Clinic provides a place for those citizens. We respectfully request that you review our existing application and feasibility study and consider it as a worthy submission as a Community Project to the US House Committee on Appropriations.

The Post Clinic has provided quality healthcare services, both medical and dental, to vulnerable and underserved populations for twenty-five years. Most of those citizens do not have insurance coverage or cannot afford the copays associated with care. Many of these citizens reside in counties which are identified as "distressed" or "at-risk". The staff of medical professionals at the clinic are all volunteers, who recognize the need of this facility for our citizens and have found a way to collaborate with each other to provide this needed service. The Post Clinic has the trust and confidence of many cooperate and citizen donors, which has allowed the clinic to continue to grow and to provide new services, like dental care. Unfortunately, the building the clinic currently uses is in dire need of an upgrade, and we believe that a new construction would enable the Post Clinic to be positioned to continue to provide quality healthcare services for another twenty-five years. Although this application is for funding to construct a new building, it is the citizens of our community who will benefit for years to come.

Our city and our citizens are committed to this project. Rarely do you find projects like this that will improve both the health and economic conditions of a community. We thank you for your full support and consideration of our application. Please let me know if further information is needed or required.

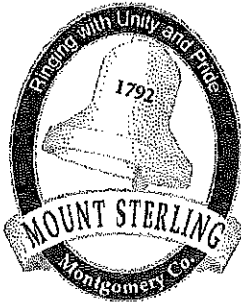

ON behalf of the Mount Sterling – Montgomery County Industrial Authority, please accept this letter of support for the City of Mount Sterling's grant application for The Post Clinic Project. 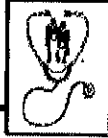
